

# ADVERTISEMENT FOR CONSULTANCY TO CONDUCT END-LINE EVALUATION FOR Peek PROGRAM

#### 1. Background

## 1.1. Kilimanjaro Christian Medical Centre (KCMC)

Kilimanjaro Christian Medical Centre is located in the foothills of the snow-capped, Mount Kilimanjaro, Tanzania. It was opened in March 1971 by the Good Samaritan Foundation, who planned and raised large funds to build and equip it. KCMC is a referral hospital for over 15 million people in Northern Tanzania. The hospital is a huge complex with 500-800 inpatients in 630 official beds, 90 canvas, 40 baby Incubators, 1852 students, 1300 staff and 1000 visitors and companions daily.

## 1.2. KCMC Partnership with CBM

CBM Tanzania has established a partnership with Kilimanjaro Christian Medical Centre in Moshi since 1971 to implement a project on prevention of avoidable blindness by focusing on provision of quality eye health care training of eye health care cadres and conducting quality eye health care research to identify areas of need for the purpose of improving service delivery.

## 2. Program Background

KCMC Eye Department has been collaborating with the Ministry of Health, President Office-Regional Administration and Local Government and CBM to implement a program titled *A Comprehensive Eye Care Program that Uses Technology for Screening at Mwanga and Hai Districts in Kilimanjaro Region*, *Tanzania*. This is a two years' program, aiming at contributing to the reduction of prevalence of visual impairment and avoidable blindness by strengthen eye health systems across primary, secondary and tertiary level facilities, also to provide affordable and accessible eye care services for the target population in an equitable and inclusive way. The program is implemented in Hai and Mwanga District, started in January 2021 to December 2022.

## Structure of Authority

The Independent Consultant will work closer with the Project Lead and Project Coordinator.

#### Responsibilities in deliverance

The Independent consultant is expected to deliver the following Evaluation products:

- 1. To access the effectiveness, efficiency, relevance, coherence, inclusiveness, impact and sustainability of the Peek Program.
- 2. To identify any problems or challenges that the program has encountered.
- 3. To issue recommendations and to identify lessons to be learned on design, implementation and management.
- 4. To provide findings and conclusions to meet accountability requirements, and recommendations and lessons learned to contribute to the program's improvement and broader organization learning.
- 5. To seek to answer the 'why 'question by identifying factors contributing to (or inhibiting) successful delivery of the results. In addition to assessing the final outcomes achieved, the evaluation focuses on assessing the impacts of the program, as well as its delivery.
- To compare the outcome with baseline conditions (if available) and assess change. The evaluation should also include recommendations and identified key learnings for future projects.

### **Qualifications and Experience**

The Consultant is expected to have the following qualifications;

- Advanced degree/MSc degree in Public Health/Projects
  Management/Statistics/Community Studies/Development studies/ Social
  Science/Population Studies/Public Administration or any equivalent
  qualification from a recognized institution.
- Registered business name, with tax clearance operating within Tanzania legal frameworks able to comply with TRA tax regulations including provision of EFD receipt.
- Knowledge and practical experience in working with eye care programmes.
- Proven senior-level evaluation experience (at least 5 years) including knowledge of different evaluation methodologies.
- Strong experience in disability inclusive development (DID).
- Strong analytical skills and ability to clearly synthesize and present findings.
- Ability to provide strategic recommendations to key stakeholders.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills including ability to facilitate and work in a multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary team
- Ability to draw practical conclusions and to prepare well-written reports in a timely manner and availability during the proposed period.
- Ability to communicate strongly using English and Swahili language

## Conditions and payment:

- The Consultant will use her/his own office/resources/materials and computer in the execution of this assignment.
- The consultant has to ensure complete data security for all data collected, provided or processed during the evaluation. All personal data has to be stored securely and has to be deleted after the assignment is completed.
